Each precious dial in the Continuity ladies' collection is a tale in its own right.

Some are accompanied by a project specifically dedicated to the natural beauty that surrounds us. The various decoration techniques used imbue these watches with a distinctive aura. A unique stagesetting featuring *cloisonné grand feu* enamelling, meticulous metal cutting, the subtle integration of jewellery motifs, along with diamond dust and precious stones, create a stunning backdrop for this tale to be experienced with elegance and genuine awareness.

These dainty watches are designed for refined and responsible women.

To inaugurate the launch of the Continuity ladies' collection, Blacksand Genève presents two models: Sea Turtle and Koala. These individually numbered timepieces, issued in 8-piece limited editions for each model, bear eloquent testimony to what can happen when sophistication meets responsibility in order to lend a unique dimension to the passing of time.

This simple yet ingenious movement serves to play with the dial aesthetic and to tell the story of time in a fanciful, elegant manner.

Named in reference to the year the founder's daughter was born, Calibre 1999 sets the stage for a collection that celebrates the beauty that surrounds us and must be preserved and handed down to future generations.

Day and night self-winding movement developed on the basis of a Soprod A10 movement, 28,800 vibrations per hour; jumping hours with dragging-type minutes display disc.
